Dear Mr. Sampson

As mandated by the Deputy Assistant Secretary for Countermeasures, a Bureau of Diplomatic Security (DS) engineer has conducted a Forced Entry/Ballistic Resistance (FE/BR) technical review of U.S. Bullet Proofing's new proposed design for their USAD Model 100-15R Full Vision (FV), Dual Vision (DV), and Opaque (OP) doors.. Upon review, your request to increase the bottom door rail from 6-3/4" to 10" in order to meet the Americans with Disabilities Act, is approved. This modification will add an additional 1/2" A193 Grade B7 Steel all thread to the construction, to enhance the doors strength to resist FE attacks. This modification will not change the level of BR protection provided by your design.

Under the provisions of SD-STD-01.01, Revision G (Amended), *Certification Standard, Forced Entry and Ballistic Resistance of Structural Systems*, these systems are certified with a Department of State (DOS) code of 1123/6123 and the DOS model numbers shown above. Please refer to that DOS model number in all correspondence with the Department of State.

These products will be placed on the DS-certified equipment list that is available for DOS architects, engineers and planners. Please note that your products must also meet Overseas Buildings Operations (OBO) specifications and compete with others that have the same certification classifications. The Department of State cannot guarantee your product will be chosen for our facilities. Thank you for your interest and endeavors in protecting our personnel and facilities overseas.
